

Error Diagnosis on Pipe Transports

Maildrop exits in certain cases with exit code 75. This signals a temporary error to Exim, but no further explanation can be learned from the exim log file:

```
2009-06-09 11:58:32 1MDy6C-0003Lm-Ky == [[mailto:racke@linuxia.de][racke@linuxia.de]] R=virtualuser
```

For better diagnosis, add the `log_defer_output` and `log_fail_output` options to the corresponding pipe transport, e.g.:

```
vinson_virtualuser_drop:

command = /usr/bin/maildrop -d virtmail
```

environment = VUSER=$local_part@$domain:${lookup mysql{select concat('VDIR=',maildir,':VAWAY=',absen
